[3] Implementation of the subject is calculated in a way that the tuition fee for 1 year is divided by 60 (ECTS) and multiplied with the number of ECTS points for that particular subject.

\* The basic measurement unit for calculation of obligations for the study program is a credit point (ECTS). The sum is calculated in a way that the tuition fee for the year is divided by 60. One academic year lasts (per definition) 12 months and includes 60 ECTS points. For students without status, one exam attempt (Para 4, Art. 26) of diploma thesis is calculated in a way that the value of the ECTS point from Part 4 of the price list is multiplied with the number of ECTS points. Students that exceed the number of ECTS points in one year, must pay the difference. A student can for example enroll into the 2<sup>nd</sup> year according to transfer criteria, and can perform 15 ECTS points with the missing ("differential") exams from the 1<sup>st</sup> year, and 60 ECTS points from year 2. Said difference in surplus of 15 credit points, obtained in one year, must be paid in addition, or calculated towards the tuition fee for the next academic

year. This also applies in case of smaller groups of students due to lower student numbers in individual years, who are allowed to perform exams from (higher) years other than the one, they are currently enrolled in.
